

Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District No. 1 was held on Wednesday, March 6, 2013 at 7:00 P.M.

Commissioner Todd Howell called the meeting to order.

John Ur, Clerk: Mr. President – All the requirements of the “Open Public Meeting Act” have been complied with by advertising in the Home News Tribune and Star Ledger. Copies of the meeting notice have been sent to the Municipal Clerk’s Office and posted on the bulletin boards of the fire house and the post offices of Woodbridge and Sewaren. Mr. President, you may proceed.

Commissioner Todd Howell led a pledge to the flag.

A moment of silence was observed for our departed members and all our troops that are under arms throughout the world.

PRESENT: Commissioner John C. Kenny, Commissioner Richard Gould, Commissioner Todd Howell, Commissioner Ken Gardner, Commissioner Patrick Kenny
ALSO PRESENT: Attorney – Christopher Howell
Clerk – John Ur

Commissioner T.H.: The first item of business is a Resolution to certify the election. Whereas the Board of Fire Commissioners Woodbridge Fire District #1, Woodbridge held the annual election in accordance with NJSA40A:17-72 on February 16th, 2013 and whereas the election was held in the time and manner prescribed by statute therefore be it resolved that the results of the election were as follows: Fire Commissioner for three years – Richard Gould 107 votes; Todd Howell 105 votes; Write-in 0. Public question No. 1 – Shall the sum of \$7,311,562.00 be appropriated for current expenses the answer was Yes 111 votes, No 26 votes. The Chair will entertain a motion to approve this.

Commissioner Patrick Kenny made a motion to approve the election results which was seconded by Commissioner Richard Gould and carried unanimously with a roll call vote.

Commissioner T.H.: At this time we’ll have the oath of office that has to be administered to myself and Richard Gould.

Christopher Howell administered the oath of office to Todd Howell and Richard Gould.

Commissioner T.H.: I need a motion and a second to vacate all the offices and appoint the clerk to conduct an election for president.

Commissioner John C. Kenny made a motion to appoint the clerk to conduct an election for president which was seconded by Commissioner Richard Gould and carried unanimously.

John Ur: At this time the nomination for president is declared open.

Commissioner J.C.K.: I make a nomination for Todd Howell for President.

Commissioner K.G.: Second.

Commissioner T.H.: Are there any other nominations?

Commissioner P.K.: Mr. President, I make a motion to close the nominations.

Commissioner Patrick Kenny made a motion to close the nominations and elect Todd Howell for President which was seconded by Commissioner John C. Kenny and carried unanimously with a roll call.

John Ur: Mr. President, you may assume the Chair.

Commissioner T.H.: Thank you John, thank you very much. Thank you for your confidence in me.

Commissioner R.G.: Wear it in good health.

Commissioner T.H.: Okay, at this time nominations for Vice-President are open.

Commissioner J.C.K.: I nominate Ken Gardner for Vice-President.

Commissioner P.K.: I'll second it.

Commissioner T.H.: It's moved and seconded to nominate Kenneth Gardner to be Vice-President.

Commissioner P.K.: I'll make a motion to close the nominations.

Commissioner Pat Kenny made a motion to close the nominations and elect Kenneth Gardner for Vice-President which were seconded by Commissioner John C. Kenny and carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

John Ur: Congratulations Mr. Vice-President.

Commissioner K.G.: Thank you.

Commissioner T.H.: Now we'll entertain motions for nominations for 2nd Vice-President.

Commissioner P.K.: I'll nominate John C. Kenny.

Commissioner K.G.: Second that.

Commissioner T.H.: Moved and seconded to nominate John C. Kenny.

Commissioner P.K.: I'll make a motion to close the nominations.

Commissioner Pat Kenny made a motion to close the nominations and elect John C. Kenny for 2nd Vice-President which was seconded by Commissioner Ken Gardner and carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

John Ur: Congratulations Mr. Kenny.

Commissioner J.C.K.: Thank you.

Commissioner T.H.: Nominations for treasurer are now open.

Commissioner J.C.K.: I nominate Patrick Kenny for treasurer.

Commissioner R.G.: Second.

Commissioner T.H.: Moved and seconded. Move the nominations be closed.

Commissioner J.C.K.: I move the nominations be closed.

Commissioner John C. Kenny made a motion to close the nominations and elect Patrick Kenny for treasurer which was seconded by Commissioner Ken Gardner and carried unanimously with a roll call vote.

John Ur: Congratulations Mr. Kenny.

Commissioner T.H.: And now nominations for secretary.

Commissioner P.K.: I'll nominate Richard Gould for secretary.

Commissioner K.G.: Second.

Commissioner P.K.: I'll make a motion to close the nominations.

Commissioner J.C.K.: Second.

Commissioner Patrick Kenny made a motion to close the nominations and elect Richard Gould for secretary which was seconded by Commissioner John C. Kenny and carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

Commissioner T.H.: Appointment of our District Clerk, Mr. John Ur.

Commissioner P.K.: I'll make the nomination to appoint to Mr. Ur as the clerk.

Commissioner R.G.: I'll second it.

Commissioner P.K.: I'll make a motion to close the nominations.

Commissioner R.G.: Second.

Commissioner T.H.: Moved and seconded to appoint John Ur as District Clerk.

Commissioner Patrick Kenny made a motion to close the nominations and elect John Ur for district clerk which was seconded by Commissioner Richard Gould and carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

Commissioner T.H.: Thank you, appointment of our physician which is JFK Hospital.

Commissioner P.K.: I'll make the nomination for JFK.

Commissioner J.C.K.: Second.

Commissioner Patrick Kenny made a motion for JFK for the appointment of physician which was seconded by Commissioner John C. Kenny and carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

Commissioner T.H.: Appointment of our fire official, Lieutenant Keith Repace.

Commissioner P.K.: I'd like to nominate Keith Repace, Lieutenant, for fire official.

Commissioner R.G.: I'll second that.

Commissioner Patrick Kenny made a motion for Keith Repace for the fire official which was seconded by Commissioner Richard Gould and carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

Commissioner T.H.: Appointment of our computer support vendor, Best Tech.

Commissioner P.K.: I'll make the nomination for Best Tech.

Commissioner J.C.K.: Second.

Commissioner Patrick Kenny made a motion for Best Tech for the appointment of computer support vendor which was seconded by Commissioner John C. Kenny and carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

Commissioner T.H.: Okay gentleman, thank you. The following committees will stand. They're pretty much what they were last year. Personnel Committee – Chairman of the committee is myself; Assistant Chairman is Patrick Kenny. Equipment and Apparatus – Chairman is myself and followed by Assistant Chairman Kenneth Gardner. Building Committee – Commissioner Gardner and his assistant is Patrick Kenny. Fire Prevention – Commissioner Gould and his assistant is Patrick Kenny. Hydrants and Radios – Patrick Kenny and his assistant will be Commissioner Gould. Safety Committee – Commissioner Gardner and his assistant is J.C. Kenny. Liaison to the Volunteer Fire Company – Commissioner Gardner with his assistant myself. Purchasing – Commissioner Gardner and his assistant John C. Kenny. A roll call vote was taken and was carried unanimously. Newspaper will be the Home News Tribune and the Star-Ledger. The banks are the Columbia Savings and the Sovereign Bank. A roll call vote was taken and was carried unanimously. Designation for authorized signatures on the bank accounts. The voucher, Fire Prevention Bureau and special accounts, two signatures signed and counter signed by the President or Vice-President and 2nd Vice-President and the Treasurer or Clerk. A roll call vote was taken and carried unanimously. I need a motion authorizing the President, Vice-President, 2nd Vice- President, treasurer and clerk to sign and countersign.

Commissioner Patrick Kenny made a motion for the President, Vice-President, 2nd Vice-President, Treasurer or Clerk to sign and countersign the vouchers which was seconded by Commissioner John C. Kenny and carried unanimously.

Commissioner T.H.: Payroll and petty cash accounts, one signature by the President, Vice-President, 2nd Vice-President, Treasurer or Clerk. I need a motion requiring one signature and authorizing the President, Vice-President, 2nd Vice-President, Treasurer or Clerk.

Commissioner John C. Kenny made a motion for one signature by the President, Vice-President, 2nd Vice-President, Treasurer or Clerk for the payroll and petty cash accounts which was seconded by Commissioner Patrick Kenny and carried unanimously.

Commissioner T.H.: Thank you very much gentlemen. At this point we will go into our regular order of business which would be the minutes of the previous meeting.

Commissioner John C. Kenny made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 6th, 2012 Regular Meeting which was seconded by Commissioner Patrick Kenny and carried unanimously.

Commissioner T.H.: Committee Reports – Personnel.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

PERSONNEL:

Commissioner T.H.: I'll report that everything seems be going along very well. We have no problems with the career side. That's the end of the report. Building and Grounds – Commissioner Gardner.

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS:

Commissioner K.G.: The contractor for the bathroom project has the necessary permits in place so we'll be starting demolition soon. We'll give proper notification to the career department when we're going to start that project. We have some minor selections to make on colors and things of that nature, type of tile. Just some minor things but we'll be moving forward shortly on that.

Commissioner T.H.: Very good.

Commissioner K.G.: We're waiting for the contractor with the motors for the doors to be done. We had the electrical work to be completed but that should be completed shortly as well. The stove foot was cleaned in the past few weeks and I guess we're just waiting for the lights to come back on for the front of the building. I think that's all for now.

Commissioner T.H.: I'll report under Equipment that we have the normal repairs to the engines and next month, the month of April, we'll be starting the spring pm to the engines. That's the end of the report. Purchasing – Commissioner Gardner.

Commissioner T.H.: Thank you. Fire Prevention – Commissioner Gould.

FIRE PREVENTION:

Commissioner R.G.: Progress.

Commissioner T.H.: Radios and Hydrants – Commissioner Patrick Kenny.

RADIO AND HYDRANTS:

Commissioner P.K.: Just a report that in the last month the console downstairs, one of the consoles, had failed and set the alert to Motorola. They took the job and they came and fixed it. While they were here fixing it Commissioner Gardner actually talked to them and got the fire ground channel put on to the base station for the watch

desk for the storms and stuff. I want to thank him for taking care of that. Everything else is up and running right now.

Commissioner T.H.: Thank you. Liaison to the Volunteer Fire Company – Commissioner Gardner.

LIAISON TO THE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY:

Commissioner K.G.: We have the parade this Sunday and outside of that I'll leave it to the chief to remind me of anything else.

Commissioner T.H.: Thank you. Report of Payroll and Bills.

I passed that information along to the union for them to review and our insurance consultant has told us that we can sign a contract with Delta Dental, our current provider, and that if we decide to change we can cancel that contract within thirty days. So last month the Board gave myself the permission to sign the contract with your approval because you were going to be out of town so we signed that contract as well. So just an update we're waiting for the union to get back. Once they do I'll notify the Board of their intention.

Commissioner J.C.K.: I'd like to compliment Commissioner Gardner because I see that Delta Dental is holding their price for another two years.

Commissioner K.G.: Right, when we went to them and were asking for information about the contract because we wanted to provide level coverage that they're smart enough to know that means we're looking elsewhere so they sharpened their pencils so if nothing else thanks Jack.

Commissioner T.H.: Thank you.

Commissioner J.C.K.: I picked up that.

Commissioner T.H.: Thank you, very good, that's good news. Chief.
